

Need a Word of Encouragement for Relationships? Doug Addison with Wendy Griffith [Episode 51] April 25, 2018

Hey, everybody! Welcome to another *Spirit Connection Podcast*. You know, God is using the airways. He wants to use TV, radio, the internet, movies, television. He wants to use these things. It's so important that we redeem them in our lives.

And not everything is evil. We don't want to kick everything out, kick the baby out with the bathwater, because God wants to use the things that people are used to seeing each day. For me, you know, I don't really get into a lot of TV, but I do live right outside of Hollywood. I can see the Hollywood sign from my house, and I am aware of what's going on in pop culture because it's so important.

No matter where you live or what you do, God wants to use media in your life. Now, I pray the news all the time. I'm connected on my app with, you know, AP News alerts so I know what's going on. I'm an avid intercessor over the news and, especially, I have an assignment for Government.

Some people are freaked out right now by all the bad news that's out there but, you know, we need to press in. We need to see that God is moving in the midst of all of this, and there are places that have actually good news.

I have a special guest and a good friend of mine on the broadcast today. Her name is Wendy Griffith. She is a reporter with CBN, the Christian Broadcasting Network news. She is actually an anchor of Christian World News as well, and she is alongside of Pat Robertson. Maybe you've seen her on TV. She also reports on a wide range of issues around the world including ... Boy, she's traveled internationally and reported on revival. She also co-anchors Christian World News, which is on Friday evenings on TBN, as well.

Now, this is a good friend of mine. I really love Wendy. We met a few years ago at a conference, and she really does have the ability to hear the voice of God. And I really love what her and Pat Robertson and the others on TBN ... I really love what they do when they get the words of knowledge and pray for people. She is so powerful with the

gift of word of knowledge, but she also has a message for women and setting people free to be able to be themselves. She has a powerful anointing in that.

She is the author of a couple of books. She is a co-author of a book called <u>Praying the News: Your Prayers Are More Powerful Than You Know</u>, and also a second book which is <u>You Are A Prize to Be Won: Don't Settle For Second Best</u>.

Doug: My good friend, Wendy Griffith, welcome to the broadcast.

Wendy: Doug, it's so great to be here with you. I always just can't help smiling when

I'm talking to you.

Doug: Wow! You know, I've been waiting for this. You know, we had to book way in

advance because Wendy does a lot of stuff. I was mentioning before that we met a few years at an Elijah List Conference back near Washington, DC

I think it was.

Wendy: Yes.

Doug: And we've stayed connected. I just really love what you do. Why don't you

just tell us more about who you are and what you do?

Wendy: Sure. Well, I am right now a co-host, one of the co-hosts, of *The 700 Club*.

We're based here in Virginia Beach, but I have been with CBN, The Christian

Broadcasting Network, for 19 years now.

Doug: Wow.

Wendy: I've been in television 30 years this year!

Doug: Oh, my.

Wendy: So, I feel really blessed that I've had 3 decades doing what I wanted to do

since I was a little girl, which was TV. I spent the first year in secular television all over the country. I'm from West Virginia. I did get to work in TV in West Virginia, but in 1999 ... It was in 1998 the Lord said, "Send a tape to CBN." And it was a national network, and I was in a small, you know,

relatively small town, Charleston, West Virginia.

We had a viewing audience of about 37 counties. CBN has a worldwide audience, so I was a little intimidated. But I obeyed the Holy Spirit. I kind of thought it was a fluke at first. But then the Lord confirmed that it was clearly not. They were looking for somebody. They liked my tape, and I was hired in January 1999, just in time to cover the Bill Clinton impeachment trial in

Washington, DC.

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: So, yes. So that's how long I've been at CBN. But then the last 5 years I've

had my dream job, Doug, as being one of the co-hosts and working

alongside Pat Robertson, and his son Gordon, and Terry Meeuwsen, and we just have so much fun on the set. It's just, you know, it's so encouraging to ... When people come up and they say, you know, I prayed with Pat and I've

been a Christian for 30 years or 10 years or ...

In fact, today when I was co-hosting with Pat, he told me during one of the commercial breaks that we are seeing a big increase in the number of people

calling in to say that they received the Lord.

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: And it reminded me of your recent word where you talked about that this next

big revival coming and the billion—what do you call it? The billion-soul ...

Doug: The billion-soul revival, yes.

Wendy: Yes. Well, it started.

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: It's started. It's starting, and I told Pat, I said, "We've been hearing about the

revival that's coming. I think we're seeing the very beginning signs of it."

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: Because it's not like we're doing anything different. You know, we're doing

the same kind of programming that we've always done. But more people are calling in to say, you know, "How can I get saved?" or "I just got saved. Now,

what do I do?" So, that's really exciting.

Doug: Yes, and that's part of the word I got too, was it was going to start in the

church first or, you know, not so much in the streets. That's not a street thing.

You know, that's something going on in people's homes. You know?

Wendy: Yes.

Doug: And it starts first through what we already know. That's so exciting. Wow! I'm

so glad you said that.

Wendy: And, Doug, right now these might not be church people, you know, and they're calling from their home.

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: For a lot of people we are their church, you know, which is good and bad. But it's good if they're getting some ...

Doug: Take it any way you can get it.

Doug: You know, I love *The 700 Club*. I'm not a ... I'll just be honest, I'll confess. I don't watch much Christian TV. But there are times I'll click on *The 700 Club*, and there you are giving words of knowledge. And I just raise my hands and the Holy Spirit shows up right there.

This happened a few weeks ago, you know, for the healing. I'm just excited about what you guys do. I love your heart. I love the heart of the ministry.

Wendy: Aww.

Doug: And I love your prophetic words. You're building up an amazing word of knowledge gift, and it's very obvious.

Wendy: Well, you know, it's a walk of faith. And I love the fact that people, they're getting healed because God says He sends forth His Word and He heals them ...

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: And it says, "The word of faith heals the sick." So, people are receiving these words that go through the airwaves by faith. And they are getting healed in their homes, and they are calling us and letting us know. So, we get excited, and then we just want to do it again, you know? So, it's a wonderful ministry.

Doug: Yes. I love it, and I was just talking about, you know, the fact I'm in Hollywood. And, you know, we're like in different streams so to speak. But God is using one common thing—and that's media and the airways.

Wendy: Yes.

Doug: And that is so powerful right now. So that's why I'm excited to have you on the broadcast. We connect every so often. I text you a word or something like that.

Wendy: Yes, and I ...

Doug: Why don't you share the story about when we met? I gave you something.

Wendy: Yes, you did. We were at this conference. Okay, it was in Maryland.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: And it was in the fall. It was in November, late November. You know, I am 53 and I've been single all my life and never married. You know, I've had a wonderful life, but I've always desired to have that special someone. And I said, "Doug, you know, pray for me. When is my husband coming?" It was

And you said, "But you're going to need this." And you handed me a man's ring. It looked like a ... it was a silver ... It looked almost like a wedding ring. It was a band, like just a plain silver band. But inside it had the word written, strength. You said, "You're going to need strength to wait." Honestly, that was not the word I wanted to hear. I wanted to hear, "You're going to meet him next week."

2015. You said, "2017 is going to be a very important year for you, Wendy."

Doug: Right.

Wendy: "And he's going to be 6-foot-2 and eyes of blue, and ... Well, anyway, I took the ring and I held onto it. And I said, "Okay, Lord, give me strength to wait because I know Your timing is perfect, and I want Your best." And God had promised that if I waited, He would bring me His best. Well, 2017 rolled around and it was approaching summer, and I hadn't met anyone yet, and I was thinking about your word.

I was hiking in Peru and I asked my friend Jenna. I said, "Jenna, you know, can you fix me up with someone, one of your friends? Because I'm not meeting anyone." She fixed me up when we got back from Peru in late June with a guy named Bill. And we have been dating now for ... Well, we had our first date in late June. But then we didn't have another date until late July just because of our busy schedules. So, we have been dating now for 8 months, and he is everything that I've been praying for.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: As I told you before, I said, "You know, I'm from West Virginia so I'm a mountain girl at heart." And I always wanted a rugged guy. You know, I didn't want, like, the guy with soft hands. I wanted the guy who had been out hunting and fishing all day and was, you know, killing the food and cleaning it and putting it on the table. That's exactly what I got.

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: I love it! You know, we had venison for dinner twice last week that he killed.

Doug: Wow! That's amazing.

Wendy: Now, that might offend some people. Sorry if that offends anybody. But also,

he's a wonderful fisherman and, of course, we live at Virginia Beach and I love fish. So, we have the most wonderful meals, and he has a wonderful heart. All this to say, your word came to pass. You said, "Hold on 'til 2017." You gave me a man's ring and it looks, you know, very promising that this is

the one.

Doug: Yes. You know, and 8 months ... 9 months is about to birth something. I

always see prophetic words come usually, you know, things birth out—like a

baby—9 to 10 months later.

Wendy: Yes.

Doug: And something's going to happen. Now, this reminds me, by the way, of a

couple of things. We were talking and praying ahead of time, and it reminded me of my very first prophetic encounter way back in 1991. I was in bad shape, and I was going through a nasty divorce. Now I've been remarried to my wife Linda for 22 years. But that was a time when, I mean, it was really bad, you know, and it was ... When I was so down, I felt like I was standing in

darkness.

Wendy: Yes.

Doug: I had an angelic encounter, and the Lord gave me this message called

End Time Marriages. And He told me to hold onto it because—in 2004 is when it all started—that God was going to pull couples together for the purposes of the Kingdom, not just ministry. It would be business partnerships, family partnerships, because two are better than one.

And it wouldn't matter about the age. All kinds of stuff would happen. But it would start happening, and I'm telling you that your story and what you're talking about here just triggered me to say, yes, wow, something is going on right page in this area.

right now in this area.

Wendy: It's so true. I have two girlfriends who have waited a long time. One was in her mid-forties, never been married. God gave her an end time marriage.

She married a pastor who was widowed, and it happened very quickly. They

met and married within the same year.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: And she was just ecstatically happy. Then my other friend, Stacy, had been

divorced for 15 years, maybe longer. A beautiful lady, my age, ended up

marrying a guy 20 years younger, and they are incredibly happy.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: And you said that's happening, that age is not ...

Doug: That's what the Lord said, yes, and to not worry about that. In fact, one of the

early ones that I saw was my own sister who is an amazing woman of God.

She had been a widow for 17 years.

Wendy: Wow!

Doug: Then suddenly I released this end time marriage word, and then the next

thing you know she meets a guy who is a widow, 20 years older, and now they have been, I don't know ... They've been married well over 10 years.

They are amazing evangelists together.

Wendy: Ah, I love it.

Doug: And so, the Lord is doing it. See, the fact that He gave you ... You know, He'll

do something that you like, you know, and the whole thing about the hunter

and all that stuff. God is a giver of good gifts, isn't He?

Wendy: He really is because I'm kind of picky, you know. And so, but God told me,

"Just keep waiting." And He had a purpose in the waiting because I, you know, it was tiresome. After I turned 50, I was getting a little irritated.

Doug: Right.

Wendy: Now, God had told me in my late thirties ... I had a very clear word from the

Lord that I would have to wait for my husband. And I was having a great time. I didn't even want to get married then because I was traveling all over the

world, and doing exciting stories for CBN, and my TV career was taking off.

But when I turned 40, I remember driving down the road and screaming. And it wasn't necessarily a good scream. It was sort of like, "Okay, God, where is he?" But it wasn't time. I was rushing it. Little did I know, you know, that I

would be, you know, well into my fifties.

But, I'm telling you, Joel 2, Doug, God restores the years. I wouldn't trade anything. You know, Bill, my boyfriend now, is 5 years older than me. Well, he's 4-1/2 and, I don't know, it's perfect.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: It's like, you know, everything is going great so ...

Doug: Yes. You know, I just released a prophetic word. This was, of course, in March 2018. By the way, prophetic words ... God's outside of time, so you can be listening to this anytime, and this is applicable for you right now.

But I released a prophetic word that 2014 (I just realized this) that God is repaying things that started in 2014.

Wendy: Wow!

Doug: And I remember when I met you in 2015, you had just released your book,

You Are A Prize To Be Won: Don't Settle For Second Best.

Wendy: Yes, Don't Settle For Second Best.

Doug: That was in January 2014.

Wendy: Yes! Yes!

Doug: And that you were really vulnerable in that book, and you shared your heart

of how you had been in a relationship. Well, why don't you just share about

it?

Wendy: Yes. I thought I'd met "the one" in 2011. We dated for an entire year. It was

interesting because we, we started dating a couple of days after Valentine's Day in the year 2011. And we broke up about a week before Valentine's Day

in 2012.

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: And I was, you know, so bummed. And I said, "Lord, why? I missed

Valentine's Day both years." He said, "Because he wasn't your valentine."

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: Guess what? This year I was dating someone on Valentine's Day, and I got

the royal treatment. I got the dinner, I got the balloons, I got ... and it was like, "Lord, thank You!" I mean, I know it's just ... You know, maybe you have

to be a girl to understand this, Doug. But it was, it was so meaningful to me because I had missed so many Valentine's Days.

Doug: Right.

Wendy: You know, maybe once you get married and you're comfortable, you don't

have to necessarily celebrate your love on a specific day. But I know God. He cares about the things we care about. And He was letting me know, "That

other guy was not your valentine."

Doug: Exactly.

Wendy: So ... But anyway, yes, that book, it did ... It was a wonderful experience

writing it. And I got incredible feedback, and I still get emails from women who say that the book, you know, encouraged them and helped them in so many ways. Whether they were going through heartbreak, like I was, or they were just out in the dating world and looking for, you know, smart ways to

date.

Yes, I was thinking, because we broke up in 2012, I was like, "Okay, where is he?" You know, I thought, because God had told me, I dedicated that book to my future husband. And God said, "Okay, now. Now I can bring you My best." And the Lord told me two other things. He said, "You haven't missed

it," and "It's not too late."

Doug: Wow!

Wendy: Because by now I was in my late forties. And I'm thinking ... You know, when

you're in your forties, 50 seems ancient. And now that I'm in my fifties ... It's

always 10 years ahead which seems old.

Doug: Yes, I know.

Wendy: I don't feel old anymore. I feel really young now.

Doug: Good, good.

Wendy: You know, I don't know what I was thinking. But all that to say, yes, it felt like

a long wait between the time of the breakup, and then writing the book, and then meeting my now boyfriend. That's why your word meant so much to me

when I got it in late 2015. Basically, I felt ...

Doug: Yes. It gave you the hope.

Wendy: It gave me hope.

Doug: Right. Well, you know ...?

Wendy: If someone is listening right now I just ... You know, if you're waiting like I was and, God willing, you're not going to be waiting as long as I was because ... But, you know, don't give up. Don't give up. You know, God is

going to give you the desires of your heart. Don't settle.

It's so easy to settle during the waiting because, you know, you're tired of being lonely. You get tired and you start telling yourself, "Well maybe this is, you know, or this is as good as it gets." No. God promises His best to His children. He's not capable of giving us anything but His best.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy: So, if you feel like you're in a relationship right now where you feel like this is not God's best, or you don't have peace, get out. Get out now because you want ... You don't want to be with the wrong person when God sends the right person. You know, God couldn't send Isaac until Ishmael was sent

away.

Doug: Right. Yes. Wow! That's a good word. People are in different places, you know? And some are single, and some are divorced, and that was part of the end time marriage word I got. The Lord said that some had been kept single—and this was back in 1991, so it's outside of time—and some had been kept single for a very long time, waiting for this end time marriage.

Others had been divorced. Others had been widowed. You know, there were all these different ones. But the Lord said He's going to do a move, and all of a sudden there's going to be a synergy in the Spirit because two are better than one.

And there's going to be a synergy in the Spirit, and the wind of the Spirit is going to shift. In fact, I had no idea at the time. You know, it was in 1991. I had just come back to the Lord. I came out of the occult after a big backslide in 1988.

Wendy: Wow!

Doug: And I was living in San Francisco. In 1991 I started operating in my prophetic gift again and had an angel encounter and wrote it down. The Lord said, "Don't release this 'til you see these things happen." And now it's happening and your testimony as well, so I'm so encouraged.

By the way, you mentioned, you reminded me at the beginning that the other

part of the prophetic word I did for March is I saw people standing in front of closed doors in darkness. Now, these were believers, and they were standing in darkness in front of a door that they knew was going to open—but it hadn't opened yet.

Then, as well, a lot of the stuff was between 2014 and 2018 now. But what you're just describing right now, is you're describing something because I saw people ... all of a sudden, the light of the Lord appeared and then ... There's a preparation going on right now for those doors to open.

Wendy:

Well, it's interesting because I love to hear God speak. And I'm always writing down in my journal like, maybe not as much as you are, but I, you know, I keep my journal, you know, but it's been kind of guiet lately.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy:

And I don't ... I know God's there, but I don't really love that but ... So, the words that He has been speaking to me I've definitely been writing down. It's interesting because He's given me the word "lamp" a few times. And I've been researching it, and Psalm 18:28 says, "For You will light my lamp." So, God says, He will light our lamp. "The Lord God will enlighten my darkness." Then in 2 Samuel it says something similar. "For You are my lamp, O Lord; the Lord will enlighten my darkness. For by You I can run against a troop." And in Psalm 119, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

It's interesting because Samuel and Psalm 18 both say, right after it talks about lamps, "For by You I can run against a troop. By my God I can leap over a wall." And I love that because, you know, here they are in darkness. But they have so much faith that, if they get that light of the Lord and that lamp from God, they'll be able to run and jump and leap over a wall. I don't know, that just struck me today.

But, you know, what really helped me in this time of just ... "Even though I'm not hearing You like I want to, You're promising that You're going to light my path. You know, You're not going to let me stumble in the darkness because You are writing my, You are enlightening my darkness." So sometimes darkness can look, like when we're not hearing from God, it can feel like darkness.

Doug:

Yes, that's important. Now, that's where the faith comes in. You know, we walk by faith, not by sight, because ... My ministry is the ministry of encouragement, and it's not just encouragement without a purpose. This is to grab hold of what the Lord is doing. I love this. Wow! Is there anything more about this gold? Keep going. This is great!

Wendy: Well, there are 18 times the word "lamp" is mentioned—at least 18, there may be more—but I'm still in the middle of this study on light. You know, it says to "be filled, be filled with the light of the Lord." So, I'm still kind of in the middle of it. I wish I had more revelation, but I don't.

Doug: Actually, that's enough because what I was seeing, and we hadn't really discussed what we were going do. I heard the Lord last fall, I think, or whenever it was I contacted you. I heard the Lord say, "You need to have Wendy on because she has a message." And when I contacted you, you didn't have a message.

Then all of a sudden, we got on the phone here and on the broadcast, and suddenly the Lord spoke. And that thing that you had about the light, and the word I had about the closed door, is now going to come into synergy and come together.

Wendy: Amen. Amen. And I thought about what the Lord said, "Don't worry about what you will speak about, for in that hour I will give it to you." So, I said, "Okay, Lord, that hour has arrived."

Doug: Yes. Exactly.

Wendy: But, you know, I didn't want to miss ... and I know some people that you interview have incredibly amazing downloads and words from God. But honestly, Doug, I'm selfish. I did not want to miss this chance to talk with you and to share also, you know, the story about the ring.

And just the encouragement that you gave me in 2015 to hold on, that God had not forgotten me in regard to meeting someone significant and special in my life. Then, of course, you had that word about the end time brides, and I think I'm right there. It's going to be a ...

Doug: Yes. Exactly.

Wendy: So, I'm excited.

Doug: And you represent a lot of people right now. I mean, I have ... When I released that book for the first time, it was called *Divine Alliances*. I pulled it off the market for a little bit because we're rewriting it, because it's new ...

You know, when it first came out in 2008 or 9 or whatever, it served a purpose for a while, for that season. But now it's a new season. And it's not so much about a book, it's about the people, it's about God opening these new things.

One of my favorite verses to pray, because I was one of the ones standing in front of a closed door. You know, I felt like things were in darkness and, yes, I felt the same. You are in the same boat right now. The Lord hasn't been speaking as loudly right now.

But one of my favorite verses, and I pray this all the time, is Daniel 2:22, "He reveals deep and hidden things and He knows what lies in darkness and light dwells in Him."

So when you're in darkness, when you're in a time where you don't know what's going on, grab hold of Daniel 2:22 and the verses that Wendy mentioned, too. Get a hold of the light. The light dwells in Him. I don't care what it looks like, I tell you, I don't care. The Lord is ... His Word is real. His Spirit is real. And He has made promises. We're about to see something, now break forth.

Wendy:

And, Doug, I'm telling you, more than ever we have to be the light. And we have to carry that light because the world around us is getting darker. All you have to do is get in your car and go for a drive to see that the world is getting darker.

Doug: Yes.

Wendy:

You know, even like, you know, our show is broadcast on a channel called Freeform, which used to be ABC Family. And right before our show comes on and goes off, there's a disclaimer that Freeform puts out that basically says, you know, "The show you're about to see, we don't have anything to do with." I'm paraphrasing, but then when the show is over it says, "Welcome back. We missed you." As if, you know, there's something wrong with us. The Bible says, "The world will hate you."

Doug: Right.

Wendy:

So, we're seeing that. But there's almost like a nastiness now to Freeform's comment about, you know, "Welcome back. We missed you." I know my spirit's grieved when I see it because they don't know what they're missing.

Doug: Exactly.

Wendy:

You know, they think we're strange—and maybe we are strange—but they don't know what they're missing. They're missing the most amazing life, and they're missing Jesus. And so, you know, you just have to pray for them. And, honestly, I have to forgive them because I just think it's kind of, you know, not very nice.

Doug:

Right. I just want to break that curse. You know, that's actually a curse of words, and they are a contract over you. You know, they have a contract. So, we're going to agree together and break that. Because if we break it, then suddenly the Lord is going to repay for those times. We're going to repay it in salvations, we're going to repay it in healings.

So, Lord, we come into agreement and break the curse of the airways right now that has been spoken over *The 700 Club* and over CBN, and where they say, "Welcome back. We missed you." We break that curse and also any other curses that have been spoken over individuals, over couples, over marriages, anything that might be hidden in darkness. Lord, we pray right now, reveal the things that lie in darkness and bring Your light.

Wendy: Yes, God. Yes.

Doug: In Jesus' Name.

Wendy: In Jesus' Name. Amen.

Doug:

Now, I thought it was important. You just revealed something. You know, the Spirit of Truth came. That's one of my ... I pray 3 verses, by the way, when I'm hearing, "Yes," "No," "Yes," "No." You know, when I say, "Lord, is that You?" "Yes," "No," "Yes." I get that. I'm a prophet even, you know?

I have 3 verses that I pray. John 6:13, But when He comes, the Spirit of Truth, He will guide you into all truth and He will not speak on His own. He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come.

2 Corinthians 2:10, These are the things that God has revealed to us by His Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God.

Then the Daniel 2:22 that ... reveals those deep things.

I tell you, I usually, I try to pray these things and take communion, and it will open the doors. Now, there are people who are standing in front of closed doors right now. And I just feel like, Wendy, you've been one of those people. And you have a door that's about to open, not just with the relationship. But it's going to be also new things in media, your career.

All the things are now coming together for you this year. And there is a strong anointing on you right now. I would you like you to just pray over our listeners and open up whatever it might be, closed doors, relationships —however the Lord leads you.

Wendy:

Wow! I have to get my breath. The anointing is so strong here in my room. Lord, I thank You for Your anointing. Lord, Your anointing, God, breaks the yoke of bondage. Lord, Your anointing, God, is power and, Lord, I just thank You so much right now for opening the doors, opening the doors that only You can open, Lord. Lord, You open doors that no man can shut, and You shut doors, God, that no man can open.

But right now, Lord, we thank You for the open doors and I thank You, Lord. That verse is coming to my mind, Lord, that You will not bring us to the time of birthing, Lord. In Isaiah, You don't bring us to the time of birthing, Lord, and not allow that baby to come forth. So, there's a birthing time, there's opening doors right now, God, that You are ... These are anointed doors, God.

Your anointing, Lord, right now is going before people and the doors are opening. God, these are doors to relationships. Doug said there were doors to ministry. Lord, there are doors for healing. Lord, there are doors where people have just been crying out for peace, Lord, in the midst of their storm, God. You're opening these doors right now for whatever their heart's desire is, God.
