



Prophetic Word: Greater Blessings as the Disasters Will Pass

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Hey friends, Doug Addison. Welcome to Spirit Connection podcast. It is September 1st, 2021. And I've got a prophetic word, not only for the month of September, but also the Jewish New Year. It's Rosh Hashanah 5782. That's the Jewish New Year. And you can chat in your questions. I'm going to be doing a Q&A at the end of the broadcast of a lot of the common questions we get in. And we want yours. We want to know what you are saying. Lord, we just ask now to come into agreement on Earth as it is in Heaven. We declare and decree this prophetic word would go out to the world without hindrances. We ask Lord, that there would be a greater blessing as the disasters pass, the greater blessing as the disasters pass. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.

Well, that's the word I got for this year. This Jewish New Year, I'm going to show you how it works here. And we still got the regular new year starting in January. But with the Jewish New Year's that start this season, I'm prophesying this—the word of the Lord that these things are going to come about. So let's take a look here, Psalm 57:1. First of all, Rosh Hashanah will be starting soon. And ooh, it's a powerful, powerful time. I'm going to walk you through how to prepare, how to get ready for it. And I'm also going to

take communion. So, I've got my communion here. You might want to get some communion for that and I'm going to show you how to open up things over you. Psalm 57:1, "Have mercy on me, my God, have mercy on me, for in you I take refuge. I take refuge in the shadow of your wings until the disaster has passed." The Lord spoke this to me. This is the word of the new year to take refuge in Him, however you need to do that. Watch as this disaster will indeed pass. The Lord is calling you to take refuge. That means just stay close to Him. Watch as the difficult times are going to begin to end. You know, we are going to see a shift that's going to happen. We're going to see a release of new healing anointing, the power over sickness, a new release of God's restoration and hope. We're going to get refreshing drinks. We're going to see the things of the Holy Spirit open up once again.

And also, the release of financial blessing and the plans from Heaven on how to increase your finances so that you can help yourself and others. So, taking refuge in the Lord will be a critical thing for right now as He's cleansing and preparing you for 2022. This is going to be a September to remember.

Zechariah 4:10, "Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices for the work to begin."

It's going to be a memorable month for many people, but also, it's a time and a turning point this month. Watch for your dreams and visions and your ability to hear the Lord to increase. It'll start off a little bit slow, but it will indeed increase. Your ability to hear His voice will increase as you'll receive plans and understanding into your situation. So don't be discouraged if things look opposite. Don't despise the days of humble beginnings, in other words. The Lord has you covered, and He will indeed make this come to pass. Just stay humble, be patient and watch as things will unfold.

There's three powerful times. There's three things that's going to happen in the month of September around the Jewish holidays. And again, it's the Jewish New Year 5782. And

we're no longer under the law of Moses—the Old Testament law. But God still operates on the Jewish calendar. And you don't have to celebrate the holidays. I don't. I don't celebrate the Seder or anything like that. But if you want to or you feel God called you to, that's fine, you have freedom to do it. But I'm just saying, this is a time that, you know, you could actually cry out to the Lord and hear Him. Just ask Him to speak but be flexible and take time to write it down. I'm saying be flexible because a lot of people get upset. They say it right away—they want an answer right away. You might have to work some things through.

So this time of Rosh Hashanah through Yom Kippur is known as the Days of Awe. It's a 10-day period. September 2021. Three powerful, powerful times. It's these three Jewish [holidays] to position you for the coming new year. Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year. It changes each year because the Jewish calendar is on 360 days. We're on 365. God still uses both calendars. The cool thing is that you could take the Jewish New Year and then we have the New Year on the Gregorian calendar coming as well. So, there's a Jewish holiday that Rosh Hashanah—it starts September 6th through the 8th. It's a time of celebration, reflection and prayer. Don't forget to celebrate. The shofar is blown a hundred times during this time, indicating that there's a new sound being released into the spiritual atmosphere to break off the old, and open the heavens for the new.

Then the second powerful time is Yom Kippur. It's a week after Rosh Hashanah. It's September 16th and 17th, and it's considered the highest holy day of the year where the Lord seals your instructions and your assignments for the coming year. He seals your instructions, so take time to reflect on the goodness of God.

Then there's a third one that most people miss. And that's the Feast of Tabernacles. That's in September ... the 20th [through] the 27th. And it's a time of celebrating God's goodness. There's an atmosphere to break off oppression and release joy into your life. So, the last day of the Feast of Tabernacles--. This is why it's so important. Most people miss this. They don't even talk about it, they focus on Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur. But

I tell you, I get visitations. I get words from the Lord on the last day of the Feast of Tabernacles, which is called Hoshana Rabbah. It's on September 27th. And this is the day that the Jewish people believe the Lord opens your instructions in the month of September of this year. But during the Yom Kippur, during this season of this time, your instructions, things that you're going to do, get sealed and Yom Kippur. And then on Hoshana Rabbah, they get revealed to you. Now, Jesus actually brings this into the New Testament. And a lot of people miss this, but it's in John 7. I invite you to read it. I'm going to read it and pray over you right now. But Jesus went to the Feast of the Tabernacles. And then it says in John 7:37–38 ... it's the last day—that's Hoshana Rabbah. And Jesus said ... “On the last and the greatest day of the feast, Jesus stood up and said in a loud voice, ‘If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. And whoever believes in me as Scripture has said, living water will flow out from them.’” Now He's talking about a spiritual thing. And so, He brings this into the New Testament. And we can get a drink of spiritual refreshment. The Lord sends a drink of living water. He will.

So Lord, we declare that right now. We say, “Open up the heavens.” We pray for the month of September as we're opening up things, as we enter into the Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year, and as we are celebrating, and that You're opening up something new, the new sound is going to open up and we will spend the time, Lord. We just pray for this time to be able to focus on You. Yom Kippur—Lord, we just come into agreement with the instructions that we can be able to hear Your voice. And then on this last day, on September 27, we just want to come into agreement on Hoshana Rabbah, during the season with the spiritual drink from Heaven. We say, Lord, give us this drink from Jesus, from the Holy Spirit that we can ... Whooo ... come into agreement.

This is going to connect you right now. So, here's how to prepare. Wow. That was powerful. And ask the Lord to show you if there's anything in your life during this month

that needs change and you know, this is not to bring condemnation. My goodness, He's not going to--, if you're ... if you're struggling with things, you know, a lot of people are dealing with addictions. You're in bad relationships. You're dealing with stuff. Continue to bring that to the Lord each day. You know, don't let the enemy get you out of this where, you know, you can ask forgiveness. You can be forgiven every day. Yes. You know, you want to grow through it, but don't get disconnected. Don't get disconnected from the Lord. He's the vine. And sometimes people tell you, you know, they say, "Yeah, but, you know, it's habitual sin, you know, you'll eventually need to--," yeah, I know. You do want to. But I'm just saying right now for people—I hear the Lord right now. Stay connected to the vine! If you have stuff in your life, stay connected. Ask forgiveness every day. How many times can you ask forgiveness? Jesus said 7 times 70 or as many times ... He didn't--, you know. There was no limit. In other words, is what He was trying to say, ask forgiveness. Because 1 John 1:9 says if we ask forgiveness, He will cleanse you of your sin and purify you of all unrighteousness. And then, of course, the Word says a prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

So, you just use this, stay connected with Him. But during this month, begin to ask Him if there's something that you need to work through or if there's some changes, in other words. I'm not trying to--, I just want to break off condemnation off people and then open it up so that you can hear His voice to get out of situations now.

So, how to prepare as well is adjust your schedule if needed. Slow down. Connect with the Lord each day and ask the Lord to give you the drink of living water or refreshment. You don't have to wait till that day. You don't have to wait until September 27th. The Lord is outside of time. The Word of God is living and active. So, you can ask every day. If you want, you can use that as a decree verse—the John [7:37–38].

Another thing that's going on right now, the Lord is going to be exalted. This is a prophetic word for the Jewish New Year—is Psalm 46:10, "But be still and know that I am God. And also, I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." I'm

going to say it again. One of the major words for the new year as we're moving in— Psalm 46:10, “Be still and know that I'm the Lord and I will be exalted and I will be exalted in the nations and on the earth.”

The Lord is calling you to be in a place of deeper intimacy. That was the Psalm 57. He was calling you to be in a place. Take that time. Be in that place. He's calling you to this place to be still and know that I'm the Lord. And also watch for things to open up. The Lord is going to do some powerful things in a positive way. He's not coming to nuke everybody, folks. Got to get that out. We've got some work to do. There's some things that we need to accomplish right now. And so some people, many people have been wondering, you know, where's the Lord in the midst of this mess and distress? I tell you; this is a year that the Lord is going to release things for you. He's going to start to restore the confidence many people have lost.

And, wow, I see something happening right now. He's going to cause people to be able to hear His voice in a greater way. He's going to speak through the Word. The prophetic is going through something. There's a change happening right now. Zechariah 4:6, the Lord says, “This is the word of the Lord ... ‘Not by might, not by power, but by my Spirit,’ says the Lord.” There's going to be a release of the Lord's power of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. So, expect that you're going to have a renewal of your strength.

Also, we're coming out of a season of distress. He's calling us to enter into a zone of less stress as He lifts the distress. He's going to lift the distress and your stress. James 4:8 says, “Draw near unto me and I will draw near--.” Well, actually he says, “Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.” I was just prophesying—draw near, draw near, draw near to God. Just stay connected to the vine. That's what I got to say. Stay connected. Don't get disconnected. One major key to draw near to God is spending time in prayer. Spend time with others and worshiping and celebrating.

Another thing He's going to do is He's going to open the storehouses of blessing. Deuteronomy 28:12, "The Lord will open the heavens, the storehouses of his bounty to send rain on your land in season and to bless the work of your hands. And you will lend the many and borrow from none." Watch for the Lord to release financial blessings ... unusual and unexpected ways. And watch the heavens to begin to open, to receive the plans from Heaven to get out of debt and to be a blessing to others. You know, we broke debt a few years ago. The Lord broke the back of debt off of us. There's an anointing to do that right now. And we're able to, you know, have money in the bank now so that I can have the freedom to do what God calls me to do, when He calls me to do it. That I can also--, my ministry, we could lend to others and borrow from none. We can be in this--. I'm telling you, the Lord's doing something right now. He's shifting things over you.

So Lord, we pray to activate this prophetic word. We ask that You would bring it about a Jesus' name. Amen.

I want to just recap some of the Jewish holidays, because--, Gosh, I got a list. I don't know how many there are, but there's five of them that I tend to focus on. And two of my prophetic mentors—Bob Jones (who's now in Heaven) and John Paul Jackson (both in Heaven). Amazing prophetic people. They were prophets, a seer-style prophets. But I had the opportunity to mentor. I worked for John Paul Jackson. He ordained me. You know, I worked closely with him and mentored in dream interpretation and in the prophetic. Lots of stuff happened years ago and as one of his instructors and outreach coordinators, actually. Amazing time of my life—wouldn't trade it for anything.

And many prophets had this special visitation on Yom Kippur or Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur ... as Bob Jones. He had a visitation of the Lord every year on Yom Kippur, he would write the prophetic word for the new year, which he called the *Shepherd's Rod*, because people would come under the shepherd's rod. And, you know, he didn't always have a face-to-face encounter. They only had a few (a very few) face-to-face encounters.

So, I had never really experienced being connected with this Jewish season. Because of this, I felt like they were-, all right, that's for the prophets and the seers, you know, Jesus comes in the room, or an angel comes in the room, you know. But then, the Lord told me one day, "Do an internet search on the dates for what's called the Days of Awe or Rosh Hashanah/Yom Kippur." Do an internet search. I want you to do this if you want. And go back to the previous ones. You know, and I've been journaling, so I now journal every day because I've activated this. But at that time, I wasn't journaling every day. But I did journal enough to have things. I found in my journals that the Lord did indeed speak to me, during--. It wasn't a visitation, so to speak, that I thought it would be. But it was. It was a visitation in a different way. And I tell you, sometimes we put too much emphasis on how it comes to us, to that visitation part of it. And if it doesn't come with the Lord coming in or, you know, if it doesn't come with an angel, then we discount it. But I say to you, hearing the still, small voice say, "I love you," you know, or the or the Lord says, "the Lord loves you." That doesn't sound like a big prophetic word, but I tell you, say it at the right time and some will burst into tears. See, it doesn't matter how, you know, how it comes or how big or big or small. What matters is the word of the Lord coming through.

So, now I realize this. I don't know when I started recognizing this, probably after 2010, maybe. But then I started becoming more intentional (actually, I think it might have been before that). I started becoming more intentional about making my calendar, setting some time aside. I don't take the week off or anything. I still work. Yeah, I still work, I still do things. But I am taking time with the Lord.

So, these five major Jewish holidays, and again, you don't have to celebrate them unless you want to. But Rosh Hashanah, which is the Jewish New Year—September 6th through 8th. Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, the highest holy day—September 16th and 17th. And then for me, the Feast of the Tabernacles at the last day, which is Hoshana Rabbah, which ties to John 7:37 is September 27th. So, these are times.

Now, there's two others that I find powerful visitations on. And I have these five. That's the only ones that I really focus on. One of them is Passover. It's a time to get strategies. Moses asked for the strategies to get the Israelites free. That's what Passover was. He got a strategy. He says, okay. It was a spirit of destruction ... was coming. And if you put the blood on the doorpost, it would pass over you. Well, it's the same thing. You can get a Passover strategy. You could get a strategy from Heaven during this season. You can get it any time. But it's more powerful during Passover, so that you could ask the Lord, you can say, "Wow, I keep getting hit or I know someone that's getting hit. In my health, I'm asking for the strategy that it would pass over. I'm getting hit in my finances. I'm asking for the strategy to pass over." Well, in 2022, Passover is April 15th through the 23rd. It's also tied with Resurrection Sunday and with Easter. Now, isn't it interesting that the Lord chose Passover to be the time that the crucifixion of Jesus, of bringing Jesus, you know, to this place was during Passover. So, there is something powerful about it.

And Pentecost. Then 50 days later, after Passover, is the time that the Lord sent the Holy Spirit. So, Passover to Pentecost is a powerful time, 49 days, the 50th day. Now there's a celebration of Pentecost as a Jewish holiday. But, you know, in the Christian Church, we have Pentecost Sunday, which is June 5th, 2022. I'm just saying, these are the five things. I'm going to give you some instructions. I'm going to do some prayer here in just a second. But the Lord will release your assignments and promotions for you during these Days of Awe.

God is releasing more. There is a lot of promotions happening. Spiritual inheritance is happening. You know, sometimes a person lays down a gift and you know, the gifts are without repentance, which means that, you know, they really can't be removed from you. But the impact of that gift might go dormant until someone else starts to pick up the impact. It might shift to someone else. These things happen during this time. The Lord is moving. This is not to scare you that you are going to lose your gifts or anything like

that. I'm just saying, gifts are shifting. There's a shifting of the gifts (that assignment) that happen a lot during this time. We're going to go through a time.

I want to do this 5-step process that I use to help open the heavens over you. And I've got communion here. You might want to get communion; you can do this later.

But step one is I go through a time of confession and ask that the Lord would reveal anything that needs attention. Psalm 139:23, "Search me, O, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there's any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."

Lord, I confess any sins right now that I've committed knowingly or unknowingly. And I ask that You would search my heart, show me if there's anything hidden or offensive to You. And Lord, I thank You for Your grace that covers over my sins for the Word of God says in 1 John 1:9, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us and purify us of all unrighteousness."

Step two is, you know, to open the heavens like this during this time, is it take your position in Christ. Take your position. In Galatians 3:27, "I am clothed in Christ." Ephesians 2:6, "And now God has raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in heavenly realms in Christ Jesus."

Lord, I am standing in your authority right now, or I'm sitting in your authority, clothed in Christ. Lord, and now, let my spirit be seated with Christ in the heavenly realm, no matter what's going on in the Earth or around me, in the room, even. I'm seated with Christ. Lord, I ask now that You would move—take us up into this higher understanding of this. No weapon formed against you will prosper, says the Lord.

And step three is decree and communion.

Lord, I decree your Word over me that I would live and not die. I tell you; the spirit of death is moving over us. And right now, I'm decreeing Ephesians 1:18. I'm decreeing over you right now, "Let the eyes of your understanding be enlightened so that you may know the hope of your calling. The riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints." And also for this time of year to be able to open up the heavens and get the strategies, I decree Isaiah 5:19 (I like this in *The Passion Translation*), "Let the prophetic plan of the Holy One of Israel come to pass quickly so that we can see what it is." So, decreeing those two.

And I'm going to take communion right now. And you know, this is the body of Jesus Christ. What He did on the cross and the blood of Jesus. It covers over a multitude of sins, so does love. Coming into agreement with love, the body and the blood.

Now, Lord, we ask You to speak to us during this season. We ask that You would open up wisdom and understanding. We open up discernment, now. We ask that You would open our eyes to see and ears to hear. We pray, Lord, that You would open our ability to understand our dreams, wisdom and understanding.

Now, I said this was a 5-step process. Step five is: record your experience. What are you hearing right now? What are you seeing, or you noticing? You know, it may come in different ways. It's not just hearing. It may come in so many different ways.

So, Lord, I pray that You would open our eyes, give us eyes to see and ears to hear what the Spirit is saying right now. Lord, we pray for Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur. We pray for this September to remember and this

prophetic word about the distress being lifted and less stress in Jesus' name. Amen.

I want to do some Q&A here real quick. First of all, a question that comes in is about the Jewish holidays. **“I struggle with the fact that, you know, I've been set free of the Old Testament. But now you're telling us that God operates on the Old Testament.”** Well, you know, one thing ... Jesus talked about it. If you take a look in the New Testament, you'll see Paul there. They celebrated the feast that I can't--. I'm looking forward to coming to you and celebrating the feast. And they actually celebrated things. So it is Old Testament and New Testament. It is not the law; it's not having to obey things. Just ... it's a freedom and the coming into alignment with this month.

Here's another one: **“What if I'm not a seer or I'm not prophetic? How can I hear God for this season?”** Well, just align. You don't have to be. Align yourself. Go back through the exercise—the 5 steps I just did. You do communion. You align yourself with hearing God and you will indeed hear the voice of the Lord.

You know, this is going to be an amazing time. I'm so, so excited. And for people who have not dreamed, I want to recommend this—is that some people, they haven't been able to dream in a while. And if you haven't, there's a prayer that you can pray. It's called the [Prayer to Release Dreams—AslansPlace.com](https://AslansPlace.com). Paul Cox is a good friend of mine. And I just felt this, that this would open some things up over people who need to tap into their dreams once more.

Lord, I thank You for Your goodness. We just give this word to You, and we ask that You would just sanctify our time. Move in power and prepare us for the new, in Jesus' name. Amen.
