



Prophetic Word: Healing, Redemption and Restoration

Hey everybody, Doug Addison here. Welcome to *Spirit Connection* podcast. It's May 31st, 2023, but this week I have a very, very special message for June 2023. But it's not limited to that time, of course. It's called "*Healing, Redemption and Restoration.*"

True Lord Jesus, we thank You for Your goodness. We thank You that we can trust You. We thank You that you're pouring out Your greater understanding, Your greater power and Your greater love. And that You're pouring out even right now: healing, redemption and restoration. We just pray also for protection over all of us. We pray for—, to be encouraged, in the name of the true Jesus. Amen.

Wow. Well, first of all, trust the Lord. Trust the Lord. Make some notes here. I do this every month, actually every week on *Spirit Connection* podcast. I'll be doing the same thing where I'll give you some Bible verses and I'm going to give you some encouraging words to go in with this. But basically, write these verses down because I'm going to be going through later in the broadcast on how to get your breakthrough and how to repent for things and open things up.

So, trust the Lord. Psalm 13:5–6, “But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation. And I will sing the Lord’s praise, for he has been good to me.”

You know, we thank You, true Lord, for Your unfailing love. We praise You and we sing to You for Your goodness, for surely, You’ve been good to us.

You know, as we continue to worship the Lord, we focus on the good things that He has done (worship, singing and joy), the Lord is going to open up to us greater understanding.

And lean not on your own understanding. I love this verse, Proverbs 3:5–6, “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him and he will make your paths straight.”

Oh, thank you, true Lord.

You trust in the Lord. And even though things might look different or opposite than what you think, I tell you, the true Lord is doing something right now. And as we do this, the Lord is going to open up to us greater understanding. He’s going to straighten out some issues and things that we’ve been dealing with.

The next verse, Isaiah 14:24. His Word and His promises still stand. This is very important to understand. Isaiah 14:24, “The Lord Almighty has sworn, ‘Surely as I have planned, so it will be and as I have purposed, so it will happen.’” Wow, that’s a powerful one. If you need to understand this, you know, the greater understanding—the Lord is going to bring deeper understanding.

He’s going to open up to us His plans and purposes. And in the process of this, we might need to let go of some things from the past. You know, things that might not have worked, things that might not, you know, have worked out the way we thought or

wanted. But ask the Lord to give you a fresh, new understanding on how to pray and how to respond, for now.

The next is healing, redemption and restoration. Psalm 103. I'm actually going to be doing several verses. Yeah, I think it's going to be 1–4. But Psalm 103, starting out with verses 1–3 (the presence of the Lord is strong right now), "Praise the Lord, all my soul; and all of my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not his benefits—who forgives you of all your sins and heals you of all your diseases."

How good is that? You know, as you praise the Lord, as you sing and worship, study and decree the Bible, you'll begin to see healing. You'll begin to see redemption and restoration in your life. You know, there's a greater power, an anointing and authority being released from the Lord right now to bring healing in all the areas of your life.

Now, here's the rest. Psalm 103:4–5 (we're talking about the Lord), "Who redeems your life from the pit and He crowns you with love and compassion, and he satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's."

Oh, my goodness. I tell you, that's Psalm 103:1–5. But this is such a powerful thing to be able to pray in. The Lord is removing many of us right now from dry times, from the wilderness seasons. And He's bringing greater understanding of His love for us. And He's releasing new hope and grace and compassion.

You know, as you worship the Lord, ask the Lord right now to refresh you in all the areas that you need—in any and all the areas that you might need. You know, He's renewing our strength. He's releasing new desires to pray, worship, read the Bible.

The Lord is renewing our strength and He's imparting to us new hope, anointing and restoration.

Thank you, true Jesus.

We just want to pray in agreement. And I'm going to go through the instructions on how to apply this even greater ... and also a prayer at the end, again.

So, true Lord Jesus. Oh, my goodness. We thank You for Your Word, the Bible. We thank You for the Holy Spirit and for the refreshment that's available to us. We ask that You bring healing, redemption and restoration. Continue to bring Bible verses to our mind that we can pray and decree to get a breakthrough.

We also ask that You would renew our strength. Bring us out of any dry times and impart to us new hope, joy, understanding ... and healing, redemption and restoration, in the name of the true Jesus.

Well, you know, each week I've been really going deeper into this on how to get a breakthrough. And this is important to really—, I think this is the most powerful thing that you can do is repentance. And so right now, I just want to just go through how to work this this month, especially is: use some Bible verses that you can use. You know, look things up, pray in promises, you know, pray and agree with others.

Also, do deep repentance in anything that you might have “in common” with what the Lord is trying to do that might stop the Lord from moving us forward. It's important to add worship and joy. You don't want to just go into this time of repentance, you gotta worship ... and joy is what you—. Go back to the podcast I've just recently released. I keep talking about the worship, singing and joy. That's important right now and decreeing the Bible verses.

So, think about it right now. What is it that you need? And let's agree together in prayer. I know that right now, that InLight Connection, we need to—, we need a breakthrough financially. And it's an urgent breakthrough for us.

I just put that out there. And, you know, if you want to respond, that's fine. But also, just right now for *your* needs and then for our needs, we're going to agree together.

So, here's how you can actually remove any strongholds, jam-ups, delays and gridlock:

We repent, renounce, and we break anything that we might have in common, including generational—sins, soul ties, curses, things all the way back that may have in common, knowingly or unknowingly, things that we may have done or that we came into agreement without knowing. We also—, we want to come into agreement with the prayers to break off the things that are holding us back. And we release forgiveness. We break off the spirit of unforgiveness.

And we, you know, I just want you to know that you don't have to agree with a person or a group to forgive them. And sometimes it's a process. You might need to get help. You don't have to contact the person to do this because it might even bring up more pain. But we just want to release the spirit of forgiveness and we just take authority over unforgiveness.

So, true Lord, we ask now for forgiveness. And if I've done anything that's hurt or harmed anyone, if I've come into agreement with anything, knowingly or unknowingly, against this message and against moving forward and stopping us from breaking out of the old season and breaking into the new, then I just—, I ask forgiveness. I forgive you, Lord.

True Lord, if I, you know, if there's areas in my life that I may have gotten unforgiveness against the Lord, and I just ask now forgiveness for everybody listening. If I've had done anything that's harmed anybody and maybe I've misused things, I don't, you know, I don't know the details. [I do this every week as I'm flushing stuff out and I'm using this as a

powerful tool.] I just ask forgiveness, true Jesus, if I've misused anything—spiritual gifts, finances, anything You've given us, known or unknown. Lord, we ask You to flush out things, seen or unseen. We ask now—, we're just going to send them and just—, we say, "Go to where the true Jesus sends you. Go to where the true Jesus sends you. Go to where the true Jesus sends you," in the name of the true Lord Jesus. Amen.
